Europe's best engineering University

As a result, the university performs very well in international rankings. For example, it ranks as the very best engineering university in Europe and as number six in the world according to the U.S. News & World Report 'Best Global Universities'.

Aalborg University also achieves a five-star ranking by the QS World University Rankings, putting Aalborg University on a par with Harvard, Oxford, Cambridge and Stanford.

Most cited professors in the world

No less than 11 Professors from Aalborg University are among the most influential researchers in the world. According to Clarivate Analytics, these 11 Professors are the most quoted Professors in scientific magazins worldwide. For example, Frede Blaabjerg, Professor in Power Electronics at Aalborg University ranks as the researcher with the highest number of quotations per publication within engineering in the world.

The best university at cooperating with companies

According to a survey performed by the Confederation of Danish Industry, Aalborg University is the best Danish university at cooperating with private companies. 44 percent of all dissertations are completed in collaboration with a company, and graduates from Aalborg University are in high demand.

400 energy researchers

During the last 30 years, Aalborg University has specialised in important areas related to the energy sector, and world class research is conducted here. For example, the university conducts cutting edge research to improve reliability, energy efficiency and cost reduction for future wind power systems. The university is home to 400 energy researchers.
