Arriving in Wuhan



One-stop Passenger Service Center at Tianhe International Airport



The One-stop Passenger Service Center is located conveniently in the Arrivals Hall of Tianhe Airport, right across from the exit for international arrivals. It offers a wide range of visitor support all in one place. Available services include mobile payment support, general travel information, transit guidance, and hotel booking consultation.

International travelers can receive on-site guidance to set up and use popular Chinese mobile payment apps such as Alipay, WeChat Pay, and UnionPay QuickPass. It's the go-to spot for visitors looking to register and activate these essential payment tools.

Transportation

Metro

Wuhan's Metro network now has 12 lines in service, operated by Wuhan Metro Group Co. Ltd. Fares are distance-based, starting at 2 yuan per ride. Wuhan's metro system is efficient and convenient, and one of the best ways to explore the city.

How to Pay for Your Ride

You have several easy payment options:
Single-journey Ticket: Buy at ticket vending machines (English available) in stations.

QR Code Payment: Use Alipay. Open the app, find "Transport" in the services section, activate the Wuhan Metro QR code, and scan at the gate.

Metro Card: Purchase a rechargeable "Wuhan Tong" card at ticket counters. Handy for frequent travel.



Finding Your Way Around

- **Metro Map:** use Amap / Baidu Map apps (turn on English mode).
- **Platform Screens:** Show train directions, next stops, and transfer information in English.
- **Station Signs:** All of the metro stations have signs and announcements in both Chinese and English.

Helpful Tips

- Trains run from around 6:00 AM to 11:00 PM (times vary by line).
- **Stay safe:** Follow signs, mind the gap, and watch your step on escalators.
- **If you need help:** Look for station staff (usually near ticket counters or platforms).

Taxis and ride-hailing cars

You can hail a taxi by the road, or you can do it via online platforms. Major car-hailing service providers in China include Didi Chuxing and Gaode.

Trains

Wuhan is a major national transport hub. There are four main railway stations in Wuhan:




Wuhan Hankou Railway Station

Serves both high-speed trains and some conventional trains (K/T/Z series), with direct trains to many provincial cities and popular tourist destinations. Located in Hankou District, connected to Metro Line 2.



Wuhan East Railway Station

Newer station in the Optics Valley area, mainly serving intercity high-speed trains to nearby cities like Ezhou, Huanggang, and Xianning. Located in the East Lake Hi-tech Development Zone, connected to Metro Line 2 and 11.



Wuhan Railway Station

Mainly serves high-speed trains (G/C/D trains) to cities like Beijing, Shanghai, Guangzhou, and Shenzhen. Located in Hongshan District, connected to Metro Line 4, 5, and 19.




Wuchang Railway Station

Primarily serves conventional trains (K, T, Z series) and a few slower high-speed trains. Located in Wuchang District, connected to Metro Line 4 and 7.

Top Ten Wuhan Dishes



Pork Rib and Lotus Root Soup

This dish features lotus root, an aquatic plant praised as the "treasure of the water", grown abundantly in the waters of Hubei.

Lotus root, pork ribs,

Fish Head Stew Served with Rice

This dish harmoniously blends tender fish and fragrant rice in a savory, umami-packed broth, with a hint of spice.

Ingredients
Fish head, rice, scallion,
ginger, garlic, etc.

Steamed Wuchang Fish

Steamed Wuchang Fish features jade-white flesh with a tender, silky texture and a delicate flavor. The dish rose to national fame after Chairman Mao celebrated it in his poem, "Just tasted the waters of Changsha, and now I dine on the fish of Wuchang."



Ingredients

Huangpi Three Treasures

Ingredients
Pork, fish, eggs,
ginger, scallion, etc.

The dish consist of three main ingredients, each symbolizes a traditional Chinese wish: the fish balls represent abundance, the pork balls signify family reunion, and the meat cakes embody the desire for continued success.

Steamed Pork Balls Coated with Glutinous Rice

Ingredients
Pork, water,
chestnuts,
glutinous rice,
ginger, scallion, etc.



Zhenzhu Yuanzi is a classic dish of Chu (Hubei Province) cuisine that embodies both traditions. Made with glutinous rice shaped like glistening pearls, they symbolize rising prosperity, family unity, and good fortune.

Braised Soft-Shell Turtle in Brown Sauce



Made with fresh soft-shell turtle and a blend of aromatic seasonings, this dish is a classic one from Hubei Province. Delicately prepared, it offers a savory, umami-rich flavor with a deep, meaty aroma.

Ingredients

Soft-shell turtle, ginger, garlic cloves, etc.

Stir-Fried Hongshan Purple-stem Mustard with Cured Pork

Named after Hongshan District in Wuhan, this dish boasts a history of over one thousand years. With its crisp-tender texture, and high nutritional value, it pairs beautifully with the savory and aromatic cured pork.



Ingredients

Hongshan Purple-stem Mustard, cured pork, etc.



Xinnong Marinated Beef

Ingredients

Premium cattle beef, cooking wine, etc.

The tradition of marinating beef from local water buffalo and domestic cattle dates back to the Ming and Qing dynasties. The beef has a rich rosy color and tender yet firm texture.

Braised Crawfish in Spicy Sauce

Ingredients

Crawfish, scallion, ginger, garlic, Sichuan peppercorns, etc.

Crawfish is one of Wuhan's most beloved freshwater delicacies. It is a must-have summer night snack for locals.



La De Tiao (SpicyJump/Marinated Spicy Bullfrog)

This Wuhan dish blends three distinctive styles of spiciness: the numbing flavor of Sichuan Province (málà), the fragrant and fiery heat of Hunan Province (xiānglà), and the fresh and savory spiciness of Hubei Province (xiānglà).

Bullfrogs, ginger, chili peppers, Sichuan peppercorns, etc.

Cultural Attractions



Yellow Crane Tower

Standing majestically on the banks of the Yangtze River, the Yellow Crane Tower is the most iconic attraction in Wuhan. It was first built in 223 AD as a watchtower for military defensive purposes and was destroyed several times in the course of history. The existing Yellow Crane Tower was built in 1985.

The tower rises five stories, each filled with captivating exhibits and attractions. The first floor houses a grand mural illustrating the legendary crane and key historical moments tied to the tower, while the upper floors display exquisite calligraphy and paintings.

One of the tower's greatest appeals lies in the breathtaking panoramic views it offers. From the higher levels, you can gaze out at the majestic Yangtze River, spot the Wuhan Yangtze River Bridge, and take in the vast urban landscape stretching into the horizon.

Yangtze River Bridge

This iconic bridge, built in 1957, is a symbol of strength and a gateway to sweeping views. At 1,670 meters long, it is a must-take route for hiking enthusiasts in Wuhan. As you walk across, admire the up-close view of the Yellow Crane Tower, look afar at the Guishan TV Tower, feel the gentle caress of the river breeze, and take in sweeping, unobstructed panoramas of both banks of the Yangtze. Locals say crossing it brings luck—why not see for yourself?

East Lake Greenway




